

Preventive Maintenance or NO VISIBLE POWDER – Law Enforcement Vehicles

Scope: SoRite[®] **DECON** recognizes the dangers associated with transporting prisoners that have been involved in drug possession incidents. **SoRite**[®] **DECON** also recognizes the importance of reducing the threat of accidental exposure to law enforcement officers from dangerous opioids. Utilizing **SoRite**[®] **DECON** properly to perform preventative maintenance decontamination of any prisoner transport vehicle will assist in reducing the threat of accidental exposure to dangerous opioids, and limit secondary contamination.

- 1. All personnel shall don, at a minimum, nitrile gloves, N-95 mask, and eye protection.
- 2. Choosing the **SoRite® DECON** ready-to-use solution container of your choice, wet all hard surfaces of the transport vehicle including but not limited to the bench seats, door panels, floorboards, soles of personnel footwear, and high contact touch points such as door handles.
- 3. To wet hard surfaces, hold the applicator 6" to 8" from the desired surface and depress the applicator. Thoroughly wet all desired surfaces.
- 4. A **SoRite**[®] **DECON** towelette can be used to wipe down electronics such as radios, keyboards, and counsels.
- 5. In the absence of towelettes, **SoRite**[®] **DECON** solution can be used to saturate a supplied microfiber towel by applying the solution directly to the towel.
- 6. All surfaces shall remain wet for a minimum of 60 seconds.
- 7. After 60 seconds, surfaces can be allowed to air dry or be dried using a supplied microfiber towel.
- 8. All used microfiber towels, towelettes, and PPE shall be placed into the provided disposal bag and sealed.
- 9. All microfiber towels, wipes, and PPE shall be disposed of in accordance with local, state, and federal guidelines.
